I, Alphons Orie, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber I of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Indictment in the case *Prosecutor v. Haraqija and Morina* (Case No. IT-04-84-R77.4) and the Order by the President of the Tribunal dated 13 February 2008, assigning the case to Trial Chamber I;

NOTING that Astrit Haraqija and Bajrush Morina (“Accused”) have been transferred to the seat of the Tribunal;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

HEREBY ORDER the detention on remand of the Accused and enjoin the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
