NOTING the confirmation of the Indictment against Baton Haxhiu on 10 April 2008 which also contained an order to the Prosecution to re-file the filing of 1 April 2008 as *ex-parte* and confidential;

NOTING the Order composing the Trial Chamber of 16 April 2008;

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS that the confidentiality of the Indictment shall be lifted, with the exception of those parts redacted in the annex attached to this order.

CHARGES

CONTEMPT OF THE TRIBUNAL

 Before and during the trial of Prosecutor v Ramush Haradinaj, Idriz Balaj and Lahi Brahimaj (IT-04-84-T) the Trial Chamber issued Orders protecting the identity of certain Prosecution witnesses.

- 2. In witness whose identity was protected by Orders of the Trial Chamber.
- 3. On ______ in contravention of those Orders, in an article he wrote and published in ______, Baton Haxhiu revealed the identity of the witness.

Baton Haxhiu knowingly and willingly interfered with the administration of justice by disclosing information relating to the proceedings in knowing violation of Orders by a Trial Chamber. By his acts and omissions, **Baton Haxhiu** committed Contempt of the Tribunal, punishable under the Tribunal's inherent powers under Rule 77 (A) (ii) of the Rules.
