**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

**NOTING** the "Second decision on failure to remove confidential information from public website and amended order in lieu of indictment", issued confidentially on 21 October 2011, whereby the Trial Chamber amended the order in lieu of indictment against Vojislav Šešelj, issued on 9 May 2011, <sup>1</sup> to include his failure to comply with the "Order to remove book from website", issued confidentially on 15 July 2011, and ordered him to appear before the Chamber at a time to be determined to enter a plea with respect to the new charge concerning his failure to comply with the order of 15 July 2011;
