NOTING that the initial appearance in this matter is scheduled for 2.15 p.m. today,

FINDING that the matter is of an urgent character and that therefore I am competent to dispose of this matter in my capacity as duty Judge,



CONSIDERING the reasons provided by the Prosecution in support of the Motion for the redaction of certain information from the original indictment as confirmed by Judge Morrison on 17 November 2009 before it is released to the public,

PURSUANT TO Rules 52 and 54 of the Rules,

HEREBY GRANT the Motion and accept the filing of the public redacted version of the indictment as attached to the Motion, as corrected.
