DECISION

THE REGISTRAR.

CONSIDERING the Statute of the Tribunal as adopted by the Security Council under Resolution 827 (1993), and in particular Article 21 thereof;

CONSIDERING the Rules of Procedure and Evidence as adopted by the Tribunal on 11 February 1994, as subsequently amended, and in particular Rules 44 and 45 thereof;

CONSIDERING the Directive on Assignment of Defence Counsel (hereinafter "the Directive") as adopted by the Tribunal on 28 July 1994, as subsequently amended, and in particular, Articles 6, 8, 10, and 16 thereof;

CONSIDERING that on 15 April 2003, Mr. Tomislav Jonjić, assigned counsel to Mr. Paško Ljubičić (hereinafter "the accused") by a decision of the Registrar dated 22 March 2002, requested the assignment of Ms. Nika Pinter, Attorney at law from Zagreb, as co-counsel for the accused;

CONSIDERING that Ms. Pinter is currently assigned as legal assistant in The Prosecutor v. Martinović & Naletilić pending before the Tribunal;

CONSIDERING however, that under article 9 of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel Appearing Before the International Tribunal (hereinafter "the Code of Conduct"), defence counsel has a duty to ensure that no conflict of interest arises;

CONSIDERING that the Registry has ascertained that there is no conflict of interest resulting from the assignment of Ms. Pinter as co-counsel for the accused;

CONSIDERING that the trial of the accused is scheduled to begin in the coming months;

CONSIDERING that on the basis of Article 16 (C) of the Directive, the Registrar may assign a second counsel to assist the lead counsel in the interests of justice;

CONSIDERING that Ms. Pinter meets the requirements for assignment as set forth in Article 14 of the Directive:

DECIDES to assign Ms. Pinter as co-counsel for the accused, effective as of 31 July 2003.
