PROSECUTOR'S INITIAL PROGRESS REPORT

- 1. The Referral Bench's Decision on Referral of Case Pursuant to Rule 11 bis with Confidential and Partly Ex Parte Annexes ("Referral Decision") of 17 November 2006 ordered the Prosecutor "to file an initial report to the Referral Bench on the progress made by the Prosecutor of Serbia in the prosecution of the Accused six weeks after transfer of the evidentiary material."
- 2. The Decision on Kovačević's Appeal against the Referral Decision dismissed the Appelant's appeal on all grounds. The Referral Decision became therefore final on 28 March 2007.²
- 3. The material supporting the indictment and other appropriate evidentiary material in *Kovačević* case was transferred from the Office of the Prosecutor to the Office of the War Crimes Prosecutor of the Republic of Serbia ("WCPRS") on 17 April 2007. The hand over of the material took place in the field office of the ICTY in Belgrade, Republic of Serbia.
- 4. The WCPRS is currently reviewing the transferred material.
