I, **MICHÈLE PICARD**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violation of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

HAVING BEEN designated as duty Judge for this period pursuant to Rule 28 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”);

NOTING the Indictment in *Prosecutor v. Jelena Rašić*, filed confidentially and *ex parte* on 9 July 2010 and confirmed on 26 August 2010;

NOTING the “Order Assigning Case to Trial Chamber and Assignment of Judges”, issued confidentially on 16 September 2010 in which Judge Burton Hall, Judge Howard Morrison, and Judge Guy Delvoie were assigned to the Bench in *Prosecutor v. Jelena Rašić* (“Trial Chamber”);

NOTING that Jelena Rašić was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 20 September 2010;

FINDING that the Trial Chamber is unavailable, that the matter is of an urgent character, and that I am therefore competent to dispose of this matter in my capacity as duty Judge;

PURSUANT TO Rule 28(D)(ii), Rule 28(E)(ii) and Rule 64 of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDER the detention on remand of Ms. Rašić and enjoin the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit of the Tribunal in The Hague to detain Ms. Rašić until further order.
