**TRIAL CHAMBER III** (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**NOTING** that for urgent personal reasons Judge Frederik Harhoff is unable to sit on 29 January 2007, 19 February 2007 and 12 March 2007;

**HEREBY DECIDES** to proceed in the absence of Judge Frederik Harhoff on 29 January 2007, 19 February 2007 and 12 March 2007.
