1. On 21 April 2005, Defence counsel for the Accused Ramush Haradinaj filed a “Defence Motion on Behalf of Ramush Haradinaj for Provisional Release”. The Trial Chamber rendered its decision on 6 June 2005, granting the motion and ordering the provisional release of the Accused. The Trial Chamber further ordered the Accused “to return to the Tribunal at such time and on such date as the Trial Chamber may order”.<sup>1</sup>

2. In accordance with the “Scheduling Order” of 24 January 2007, the pre-trial conference will take place on 1 March 2007 and the trial will commence on 5 March 2007.

3. Pursuant to Rule 54 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Trial Chamber hereby **ORDERS** that:


i. the Accused Ramush Haradinaj shall return to the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague on Monday 26 February 2007;

ii. UNMIK shall accompany the Accused on his return journey and deliver the Accused to the custody of the Dutch authorities at Schiphol Airport or any other airport in the Netherlands;

iii. the Government of the Netherlands shall ensure that the Accused is transported from Schiphol Airport or any other airport in the Netherlands to the United Nations Detention Unit;

iv. UNMIK, the Government of the Netherlands and the Registry of the Tribunal, shall communicate with each other to facilitate the orderly return of the Accused to the United Nations Detention Unit.
