## The Accused

Mr. Radovan Karadžić

**I**, **Iain Bonomy**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

**BEING SEISED OF** the "Prosecution's Notice Regarding Compliance With Decisions Re Access by Karadžić to Confidential Materials in Completed Cases and Request for Extension of Time", filed publicly on 19 June 2009 ("Request");

**NOTING** that, in the Request, the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") informs the Trial Chamber that it has, pursuant to an earlier decision of the Trial Chamber,<sup>1</sup> completed a review of confidential materials in a number of cases, in conformity with the 19 June deadline set by the Chamber, but that a similar review in 15 completed cases remains outstanding;

**NOTING** that the Prosecution requests an extension of time, up to and including 26 June 2009, in order to complete the review of the cases in question;

**NOTING** that, due to the time sensitivity of the Motion, a response from the Accused is not necessary;

**CONSIDERING** that it would be in the interests of good case management to give the Prosecution more time to review the 15 outstanding cases;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54, 65 ter, and 127 of the Rules,

**HEREBY GRANT** the Prosecution's Request and **ORDER** that the Prosecution completes its review by no later than 26 June 2009.
