THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

CONSIDERING the "Decision on Second Motion for Subpoena: Edin Garaplija" issued on 18 December 2012, in which the Chamber granted the Accused's motion filed on 3 December 2012 requesting that a subpoena be issued directing witness Edin Garaplija to appear before the Chamber to give oral testimony on 6 February 2013;

PURSUANT TO Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 54 of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules");

HEREBY REQUESTS the responsible authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina:

1. To serve the attached Subpoena ad Testificandum issued by the Trial Chamber on 18 December 2012 ("Subpoena") on Edin Garaplija; and

2. To take all reasonable and necessary measures to ensure that the above-named witness appears at the time and place indicated in the Subpoena;

3. To provide a written report either confirming, and providing details of, the actual service of the Subpoena or describing the efforts made to serve the Subpoena, and further describing the efforts made to ensure the appearance of Edin Garaplija; and

4. To provide passport information concerning Edin Garaplija within 48 hours of receipt of this Order;
