NOTING the "Order Designating the State in which Darko Mrda Is to Serve his Sentence", filed

confidentially on 6 May 2004, whereby the President of the International Tribunal designated Spain

as the state in which Darko Mrda is to serve his sentence ("Order");

CONSIDERING that Darko Mrda has already been transferred to Spain;

CONSIDERING therefore that the reason for issuing the Order on a confidential basis is no longer

applicable;
