I, FAUSTO POCAR, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

NOTING the "Order Designating the State in which Hazim Delić is to Serve his Sentence", filed

on 29 April 2003, in which the President of the International Tribunal designates Finland as the

State in which Hazim Delić is to serve his sentence ("Order");
