I, HOWARD MORRISON, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the confidential and *ex parte* “Order by Specially Designated Judge Concerning Material Potentially Subject to Lawyer-Client Privilege”, issued by me on 9 May 2013 (“Order”), which contained the conclusions of my review of potentially privileged material in the possession of the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”);

CONSIDERING that the reasons for the issuance of the Order as confidential and *ex parte* have, in my view, eclipsed;
