**TRIAL CHAMBER III** (“Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

**CONSIDERING** that Counsel for the Accused Prlić (“Prlić Defence”) requested the admission of 25 exhibits<sup>1</sup> while Counsel for the Accused Praljak (“Praljak Defence”), Counsel for the Accused Petković (“Petković Defence”) and the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) requested the admission of 1<sup>2</sup>, 2<sup>3</sup> and 6<sup>4</sup> exhibits, respectively, related to the testimony of Witness Damir Zorić (“Proposed Exhibits”) who appeared from 13 to 15 May 2008,

**CONSIDERING** that no objection to the Proposed Exhibits has been raised by the Prosecution or the Defence teams,

**CONSIDERING** that the Chamber has examined each of the Proposed Exhibits on the basis of the admissibility criteria set out in the Decision on Admission of Evidence, rendered by the Chamber on 13 July 2006 (“Decision of 13 July 2006”) and the Decision Adopting Guidelines for the Presentation of Defence Evidence, rendered by the Chamber on 24 April 2008 (“Decision of 24 April 2008”),<sup>5</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the Chamber decides to admit into evidence the Proposed Exhibits indicated “Admitted” in the Annex attached to this Decision since they were put to the witness and bear sufficient indicia of relevance, reliability and probative value,

**CONSIDERING** that the Chamber decides not to admit into evidence the Proposed Exhibits indicated “Not Admitted” in the Annex attached to this Decision since they are not consistent with the requirements set out in the Decisions of 13 July 2006 and 24 April 2008,

**PARTIALLY GRANTS** the requests for admission of the Prlić Defence and Petković Defence,

**ADMITS** into evidence the Proposed Exhibits indicated “Admitted” in the Annex attached to this Decision, **AND**

**DENIES** in all other respects the requests for admission of the Prlić Defence and Petković Defence.
