**TRIAL CHAMBER III** (“Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

***PROPRIO MOTU,***

**NOTING** the “Order to Conduct a Fresh Medical Expert Evaluation of Vojislav Šešelj”, filed publicly on 19 October 2010 (“Order of 19 October 2010”),

**NOTING** the “Order Amending the Order to Conduct a Fresh Medical Evaluation of Vojislav Šešelj Filed on 19 October 2010”, filed publicly on 18 November 2011 (“Order of 18 November 2010”), setting the time-limit for filing the expert panel’s report at 15 January 2011,

**NOTING** the Registry’s Internal Memorandum sent to the Chamber confidentially on 7 January 2011, concerning the appointment of the committee of medical experts,

**CONSIDERING** that the Chamber was informed by the Registry that the method used to appoint the international expert panel would cause additional delays beyond those anticipated by the Order of 18 November 2010,

**FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS**

**PURSUANT TO** Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

**ORDERS** that the time-limit for filing the expert panel report commissioned by the Order of 18 November 2010 be moved to 15 February 2011.
