**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

**BEING SEISED** of a "Motion for Judicial Assistance" in connection with the Peace Stabilisation Force ("SFOR") or other military and security forces operating on the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina filed

on behalf of the accused, Stevan Todorovic, on 24 November 1999 ("the Application"), seeking the assistance of the Trial Chamber in obtaining information and documents in connection with the evidentiary hearing to be held on a "Motion for an order directing the Prosecutor to forthwith return the accused Stevan Todorovic to the country of refuge" and "Accused Stevan Todorovic's Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus", both filed by the Defence for Stevan Todorovic on 21 October and 15 November 1999 respectively,

**BEING SEISED** also of a request in the form of a letter from SFOR filed on 28 June 2000 seeking an extension of time in which to file a written response to the Application (the SFOR Request"),

**NOTING** the "Prosecutor's Response to SFOR's Request for Additional time to Respond to the Defence Motion for Judicial Assistance" filed by the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") on 30 June 2000,

**NOTING** also the "Defence Response to SFOR's Request for Additional Time to Respond and Response to Prosecutor's Response" filed by the Defence for Stevan Todorovic on 3 July 2000,

**CONSIDERING** that the reasons given in support of the SFOR Request constitute good cause for the purpose of Rule 127 of the Rules,

**PURSUANT** to Rule 127 of the Rules,

**HEREBY GRANTS** the SFOR Request and **ORDERS** as follows:

1. SFOR shall have until Tuesday 18 July 2000 to file a written response to the Application, if any; and
2. a hearing on the Application shall be held on Tuesday 25 July 2000, commencing at 9.30 a.m., at which SFOR may be heard.
