
**NOTING** that the Presiding Judge stated at the Status Conference held on 22 October 2009 that it was expected that the Pre-Trial Conference would be scheduled for 16 December 2009 and the Opening Statement from the Prosecution for 17 December 2009;<sup>1</sup>

**PURSUANT TO** Rules of 73 *bis* and 84 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

**HEREBY ORDERS** that:

- (1) the Pre-Trial Conference shall be held on Wednesday 16 December 2009 at 2.15 p.m. in Courtroom 1;
- (2) the Prosecution shall make its Opening Statement on Thursday 17 December 2009 at 9.00 a.m. in Courtroom 1; and
- (3) if the Prosecution does not complete its Opening Statement on 17 December 2009, it shall be continued on Friday 18 December 2009 at 9.00 a.m. in Courtroom 1.
