The Accused Zdravko Tolimir **THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

NOTING the "Decision with Reasons to Follow on Prosecution Motion to Amend the Second Amended Indictment" issued on 9 December 2009 ("Decision"), in which the Trial Chamber ordered that that the Pre-Trial Conference scheduled for Wednesday 16 December 2009 and the Opening Statement of the Prosecution scheduled for 17 December 2009 be postponed for a period of at least two months until a date to be decided;¹

PURSUANT TO Rules of 73 bis, 84 and 85 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

HEREBY ORDERS that:

- (1) the Pre-Trial Conference shall be held on Thursday 25 February 2010 at 2.15 p.m.;
- (2) the parties may make opening statements on Friday 26 February 2010 at 2.15 p.m. and, if necessary, on Monday 1 March 2010; and
- (3) the presentation of the evidence for the Prosecution shall commence in the week beginning 8 March 2010.
