PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

Dragomir MILOŠEVIĆ Case

Trial Chamber III – Judges Robinson (Presiding), Mindua and Harhoff

Continuation of the Defence case

On 23 July 2007, the following witness was examined by the Defence, subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution and then re-examined by the Defence:

• Milosav Gagović (Yugoslav Army officer during the relevant period)-the witness testified via video-link

On 24 July 2007, the following witnesses were examined by the Defence and subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution:

- Vlastimir Glavaš (prisoner in Sarajevo and then police officer)-he was also re-examined by the Defence
- Slobodan Bjelica (newspaper editor in the Serbian part of Sarajevo during the relevant period)

On 25 July 2007, the following witness was examined by the Defence, subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution and then re-examined by the Defence:

• Witness T-60

On 26 July 2007, the following witnesses were examined by the Defence and subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution:

- *Milorad Košarac* (member of the Republika Srpska Army during the relevant period)-he was also re-examined by the Defence
- *Nedeljko Ućur* (prisoner in Sarajevo and then member of the Republika Srpska Army during the relevant period)

DECISION ON PROSECUTION MOTION PURSUANT TO RULE 73 bis(F) AND MOTION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW WITNESSES

On 24 July 2007, Trial Chamber I granted a motion and ordered that the Prosecution be permitted to place 73 witnesses on the witness list and that they be granted 109 hours for the direct examination of their witnesses.

ORDER CONCERNING NEW COUNSEL FOR ACCUSED MARKAČ AND ACCUSED ČERMAK

On 25 July 2007, pursuant to Articles 20 and 21 of the Statute and Rule 54 of the Rules, Judge Moloto ordered counsel for the accused Markač to inform the Trial Chamber by 20 August 2007 of the name of the new lead counsel for Mladen Markač. The accused Čermak was ordered to immediately engage new counsel to represent him and to inform the Chamber by 19 September 2007 of the names of lead counsel and co-counsel.
