ORDER TO PROSECUTION TO INVESTIGATE WITH A VIEW TO PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF AN INDICTMENT FOR CONTEMPT

ORDER IN LIEU OF INDICTMENT ON CONTEMPT CONCERNING DRAGAN JOKIĆ

On 1 November 2007, pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules, Trial Chamber II issued an order in lieu of an indictment against Dragan Jokić charging him with contempt because he refused to testify in the Popović et al. case. Trial Chamber II will prosecute the matter itself.
