PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 81 (D) of the Rules;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that, subject to any further order of the Chamber:

- the taking of still photographs by designated photographers at the commencement of all proceedings in this matter is authorized as directed by the Chief of Security of the Tribunal's Security Service; and
- 2. the release of the audio-visual record of all open sessions in this case is permitted as provided by the Registrar of the Tribunal.
