Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

NOTING "Vlastimir Dorđević's Notice of Translations and Correlative Motion for Admission of

Evidence" filed by Counsel for Vlastimir Đorđević ("Defence") on 1 October 2009 whereby the

MFI D264, MFI D266, MFI D268, MFI D269, MFI D270, MFI D271, MFI D281,

MFI D308, and MFI D312 be admitted into evidence as exhibits;

(ii) **REQUESTS** the Registry to change the status of the above mentioned documents and to

attach the missing translations to the respective exhibits.
