Order to Redact the Public Transcript and the Public Broadcast of a Hearing

The Trial Chamber (At the request of the Prosecutor / Defence and with the agreement of the parties) ORDERS that the following blacked-out text, page 5810 line 17 until line 21 be omitted from the public transcript of this hearing and be edited from the public broadcast of this hearing.

 812 05 32 Daily life was not very orderly. Whether some persons or not
 812 05 33 was harassed some kind of uniform. I don't really remember seeing a
 812 05 34 civilian in those first days. Maybe I didn't watch long enough but
 812 05 35 certainly I didn't remember.
 812 05 36 Q To you recall any political leaders from the Banja Luka region
 812 05 37 providing information over this local situation?
 812 05 38 A At the very beginning, the president of the Executive
 812 05 39 Council of the Bihać Municipality, Mr. Živko Blažić,
 812 05 40 presented the events of the day or possibly some plans. There should be
 812 05 41 reports on attempted breakthroughs or provocations on the front line and
 812 05 42 the like.
 812 05 43 Q Did you consider the information being provided through the local
 812 05 44 stations to be objective?
 812 05 45 A Maybe not all of it. It was a problem to estimate what was a
 812 05 46 serious attempt to break through and who provoked who. Because all sorts
 812 05 47 of things went on on the front line.

812 05 28 Q You've already mentioned some of the crimes being committed
 812 05 29 against the non-Serb population in 1993. Was any information about those
 812 05 30 crimes broadcast over the local stations?
 812 05 31 A First of all, I must say that I didn't spend much time watching
 812 05 32 TV due to the circumstances under which I lived and worked. But I did, I
 812 05 33 remember, information about crimes or executions against the perpetrators
 812 05 34. Q In paragraph 6, the witness reported that in a meeting that
 812 05 35 took place of the assembly delegates were 300 members.
 812 05 36 I believe you already talked on this topic. Was there a
 812 05 37 significant opposition in the assembly during this time-period?
 812 05 38 A I can now only interpret what I saw, although I did mention that
 812 05 39 there was another party in Banja Luka, that's the Radical Party, which was in
 812 05 40 opposition to some extent. Although they claimed that the liberalisation
 812 05 41 of the Serbian people in all territories (that point).
 812 05 42 Possibly the radicals didn't agree with all aspects of
 812 05 43 personal自由. But I don't think there was a real opposition with a
 812 05 44 different ideology.
 812 05 45 Q And just numbers wise there's a large number of opposition
 812 05 46 members?
 812 05 47 A Not 100% important to know which party we're talking about.
 812 05 48 Q Because the numbers varied. The SDS are certainly the strongest, most
 812 05 49 numerous party in the region.
 812 05 50 A The radicals sometimes rose over 5 per cent. Maybe they
 812 05 51 reached as high as 15 per cent. But then it depends on the circumstances.
