
BEING SEISED of the “Prosecution Motion for Reconsideration of Trial Chamber’s Decision on Motion for Order for Contact with Prosecution Witnesses”, filed publicly on 26 June 2009 (“Motion for Reconsideration”), whereby the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) requests the Trial Chamber to reconsider its Decision on Motion for Order for Contact with Prosecution Witnesses (“Decision”), filed on 19 June 2009, or alternatively seeks certification to appeal the Decision;¹

CONSIDERING that it would be of assistance to the Trial Chamber for the Registry to make a submission in relation to the Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to Rule 33(B) of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”),

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 65 *ter*(B) of the Rules,

HEREBY INVITE the Registry to file any submission it wishes the Trial Chamber to consider in relation to the Motion for Reconsideration, pursuant to Rule 33 (B) of the Rules, no later than **Monday, 6 July 2009**.
