THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the

Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

CONSIDERING the "Decision on Accused's Motion to Subpoena Svetozar Andrić", issued on

28 May 2013, in which the Chamber granted the Accused's "Motion for Subpoena: General

Svetozar Andrić", filed on 29 April 2013, requesting that a subpoena be issued directing

Svetozar Andrić to appear before the Chamber to give oral testimony on 19 July 2013;

PURSUANT TO Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 54 of the Tribunal's Rules

of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY REQUESTS the responsible authorities of the Republic of Serbia:

1. To serve the attached Subpoena ad Testificandum issued by the Chamber on

28 May 2013 ("Subpoena") on Svetozar Andrić; and

2. To take all reasonable and necessary measures to ensure that Svetozar Andrić appears at

the time and place indicated in the Subpoena;

3. To provide a written report either confirming, and providing details of, the actual service

of the Subpoena or describing the efforts made to serve the Subpoena, and further describing the

efforts made to ensure the appearance of Svetozar Andrić; and

4. To provide passport information concerning Svetozar Andrić within 48 hours of receipt

of this Order.
