
NOTING the confidential “Order of the President on the Early Release of Momčilo Krajišnik”, issued on 29 July 2013 (“Order”), by which I ordered the release of Mr. Krajišnik on 30 August 2013;

CONSIDERING that following Mr. Krajišnik’s release on 30 August 2013, there is no reason to maintain the confidential status of the Order;

HEREBY INSTRUCT the Registry of the Tribunal to lift the confidential status of the Order.
