THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") hereby issues this order, *ex proprio motu*, lifting the confidentiality of certain documents in connection with witnesses who were called or invited to give evidence by the Trial Chamber.

1. Milan Đaković was called as a witness in the above-captioned proceedings, and gave evidence before the Trial Chamber on 19–21 May 2008. At the conclusion of the hearing on 21 May 2008, the Chamber announced that, as the parties had already been aware but was not yet publicly known, the Chamber had endeavoured to secure the attendance of other witnesses in addition to Mr. Đaković—namely Christopher Hill, Borris Mayorski, and Aleksandar Dimitrijević—but was unable to secure their attendance.

- 2. The Chamber notes that the following documents are already filed publicly in this case:
 - a. Letter from Legal Officer of Chamber to the Legal Counsellor of the United States of America, 16 April 2008 (attaching letter to Christopher Hill);
 - b. Letter from Legal Officer of Chamber to the First Secretary Legal Advisor of the Russian Federation, 16 April 2008 (attaching letter to Borris Mayorski);
 - c. Letter from the Presiding Judge of the Chamber to the Ambassador of the Russian Federation, 18 April 2008 (attaching letter to Borris Mayorski); and
 - d. Letter from the Registrar of the Tribunal to the National Council for Cooperation with ICTY, 18 April 2008 (attaching letter to Aleksandar Dimitrijević).

3. The Chamber also notes that it will file in these proceedings public redacted versions of the following today:

- a. Summons Pursuant to Rules 54 and 98, 13 May 2008 (summoning Aleksandar Dimitrijević); and
- b. Order to the Government of the Republic of Serbia, 13 May 2008 (ordering the Republic of Serbia to serve the summons upon Aleksandar Dimitrijević).

4. The Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 53, 54, and 79 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, considers that it is no longer necessary to maintain the confidentiality of

the following documents and hereby INSTRUCTS the Registry to alter their status from confidential to public:

- a. Order Regarding Potential Witnesses to Be Called by Trial Chamber, 13 March 2008;
- b. Letter from the Presiding Judge of the Chamber to Milan Đaković, 18 March 2008; and
- c. Second Order Regarding Potential Witnesses to Be Called by Trial Chamber, 16 April 2008.
