DECISION ON DEFENCE REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Mr Branko Lukić Mr Miodrag Stojanović **TRIAL CHAMBER I** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Chamber" and "Tribunal", respectively);

BEING SEISED of a Defence request filed on 2 September 2016, seeking an extension of time of seven days to file a submission related to a potentially upcoming decision by the President of the Tribunal ("President" and "Request", respectively);

NOTING that on 5 September 2016, the Prosecution informed the Chamber and the Defence by email that it does not intend to respond to the Request;

CONSIDERING that although the Request does not specify the entity before which the Defence wishes to file a submission (for which it seeks an extension of time), the Chamber understands the Request to relate to the possibility for the Defence to file a submission for "reconsideration and/or secondary review" before the President, requesting either (i) a reconsideration of the President's decision of 26 August or of any follow-up decision, or, (ii) a referral of the matter to a panel of three judges;²

CONSIDERING that the Chamber is not competent to decide on a request to extend a time limit that may exist for submissions to be filed before the President;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

DISMISSES the Request.
