**ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT ASSIGNING
TWO *AD LITEM* JUDGES TO A TRIAL**

I, Claude Jorda, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (hereinafter "the International Tribunal"),

NOTING that the trial in the Martinović case commences on 10 September 2001 before a section of Trial Chamber I,

NOTING the need to call upon two *ad litem* judges for the trial to commence,

CONSIDERING that the *ad litem* judges are assigned to trials,

CONSIDERING that three permanent judges and a maximum at any one time of six *ad litem* judges shall be members of each Trial Chamber,

CONSIDERING that a Trial Chamber to which *ad litem* judges are assigned may be divided into sections of three judges each, composed of both permanent and *ad litem* judges,

CONSIDERING that *ad litem* Judge Maureen Harding Clark was appointed by the Secretary-General upon request of the President of the International Tribunal to serve in this trial,

CONSIDERING that *ad litem* Judge Fatoumata Diarra was appointed by the Secretary-General upon request of the President of the International Tribunal to serve in this trial,

PURSUANT to Articles 12, 13 *ter*(2) and 14(5) of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

HAVING CONSULTED the judges of the International Tribunal,

HAVING CONSULTED the presiding judge of Trial Chamber I,

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

ASSIGN *ad litem* Judge Maureen Harding Clark and *ad litem* Judge Fatoumata Diarra to trial no. IT-98-34-T, *The Prosecutor v. Vinko Martinović and Mladen Naletilić*,

CONFIRM that Trial Chamber I, Section A shall be composed as follows in this trial:

Judge Maureen Harding Clark

Judge Fatoumata Diarra
