ORDER ON REQUESTS TO ADMIT EVIDENCE RELATING TO WITNESS CYRIL RIBIČIĆ

CONSIDERING that the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") requested the admission of 15 exhibits¹ while Counsel for the Accused Prlić ("Prlić Defence") and Counsel for the Accused Stojić ("Stojić Defence") requested the admission of 19 and 4 exhibits, respectively,² related to the testimony of Witness Cyril Ribičić ("Proposed Exhibits") who appeared before the Chamber on 10 and 11 December 2007,

CONSIDERING that the Chamber has examined the objections by the Prosecution with regard to the admission of exhibits presented by the Prlić Defence³ and with regard to exhibits presented by the Stojić Defence,⁴

CONSIDERING that the Chamber notes that Exhibits P 00128, P 00440 and P 00684 requested for admission by the Prosecution were already admitted on 2 October 2006 and that, consequently, the request as far as they are concerned is moot,

CONSIDERING that the Chamber has examined each of the Proposed Exhibits on the basis of the admissibility criteria set out in its Decision of 13 July 2006 on the admission of evidence ("Decision of 13 July 2006"),

CONSIDERING that the Chamber decides to admit into evidence the Proposed Exhibits indicated "Admitted" in the Annex attached to this Decision since they were put to Witness Cyril Ribičić and bear sufficient indicia of relevance, probative value and reliability,

CONSIDERING that the Chamber decides not to admit into evidence the Proposed Exhibits indicated "Not Admitted" in the Annex attached to this Decision since they are not consistent with the instructions of the Decision of 13 July 2006,

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

PARTIALLY GRANTS the requests of the Prosecution, the Prlić Defence and the Stojić Defence,

DECIDES that the Proposed Exhibits indicated "Admitted" in the Annex attached to this Decision should be admitted into evidence, **AND**

DENIES in all the other respects the requests of the Prosecution, the Prlić Defence and the Stojić Defence for the reasons stated in the Annex attached to this Decision.
