ORDER ON THE REGISTRY SUBMISSION PURSUANT TO RULE 33(B)

The Office of the Prosecutor Mr. Mathias Marcussen

<u>The Accused</u> Mr. Vojislav Šešelj **I**, **THEODOR MERON**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal");

NOTING the "Notification/Warning to the President of the ICTY Judge Theodor Meron" filed by Mr. Dejan Mirović, Legal Advisor to Mr. Vojislav Šešelj ("Mr. Šešelj"), on 6 January 2012, which states that Mr. Šešelj was prevented by the staff of the United Nations Detention Unit ("UNDU") from photocopying a letter directed to me concerning violations of his human rights, and thereby was prevented from sending his complaint;

NOTING the "Registry Submission Pursuant to Rule 33(B) on Notification to the President Submitted by Vojislav Šešelj's Legal Advisor" filed publicly with confidential annexes by the Registry of the Tribunal ("Registry") on 9 January 2012 ("Registry Submission");

CONSIDERING that it is in the interest of justice to allow Mr. Šešelj the opportunity to respond to the Registry Submission;

HEREBY ORDER that Mr. Šešelj has ten days from the date of his return to the UNDU to file a response, if any, to the Registry Submission, after which the Registry shall have five days to file a reply, if any, to Mr. Šešelj's response.
