Note: Gojko Vasić's Annex 13 indicates 33 "criminal reports" against known Serb perpetrators. However, the supporting data that he included with Annex 13 shows that, in fact, this number represents the number of serious crimes, and not the number of criminal reports, as indicated by the entries with the same crime register (KU) entry number. See Vasić, P15582, pp.28-32. For example, criminal report KU 123/92 is listed 12 times, criminal report KU 124/92 is listed 9 times and criminal report KU 89/92 is listed twice - as each involved a criminal report with multiple perpetrators and/or victims. The actual number of criminal reports filed in 1992 against known Serb perpetrators for crimes in Banja Luka municipality is therefore 18. This adjustment is reflected in the chart above. In addition, the police filed two separate criminal reports against Goran Banjac (KU 466/92, KU 89/92), two separate criminal reports against Radomir Boškarić (KU 3405/92, KU 3065/92) and three separate criminal reports against Branko Pačković, Mirinko Gajić and their criminal group (KU 130/92, KU 123/92, KU 124/92). As these criminal reports pertained to the same perpetrators, they were combined in the Banja Luka prosecutor office's logbooks under the same entry run

In one note, an anonymous former member of the unit states "From the very beginning of this unit, many noticed, and now we have had it confirmed, that this was just someone's private gain. Now some have been thrown out of the Detachment, including myself, while those who remain in the Detachment are true thieves and criminals, since they are the ones who compiled lists for the elimination of people." Among other issues, the incident involving the setting fire to the Catholic church is discussed and agreement to investigate who had done it and to place security around the priest's house is reached. 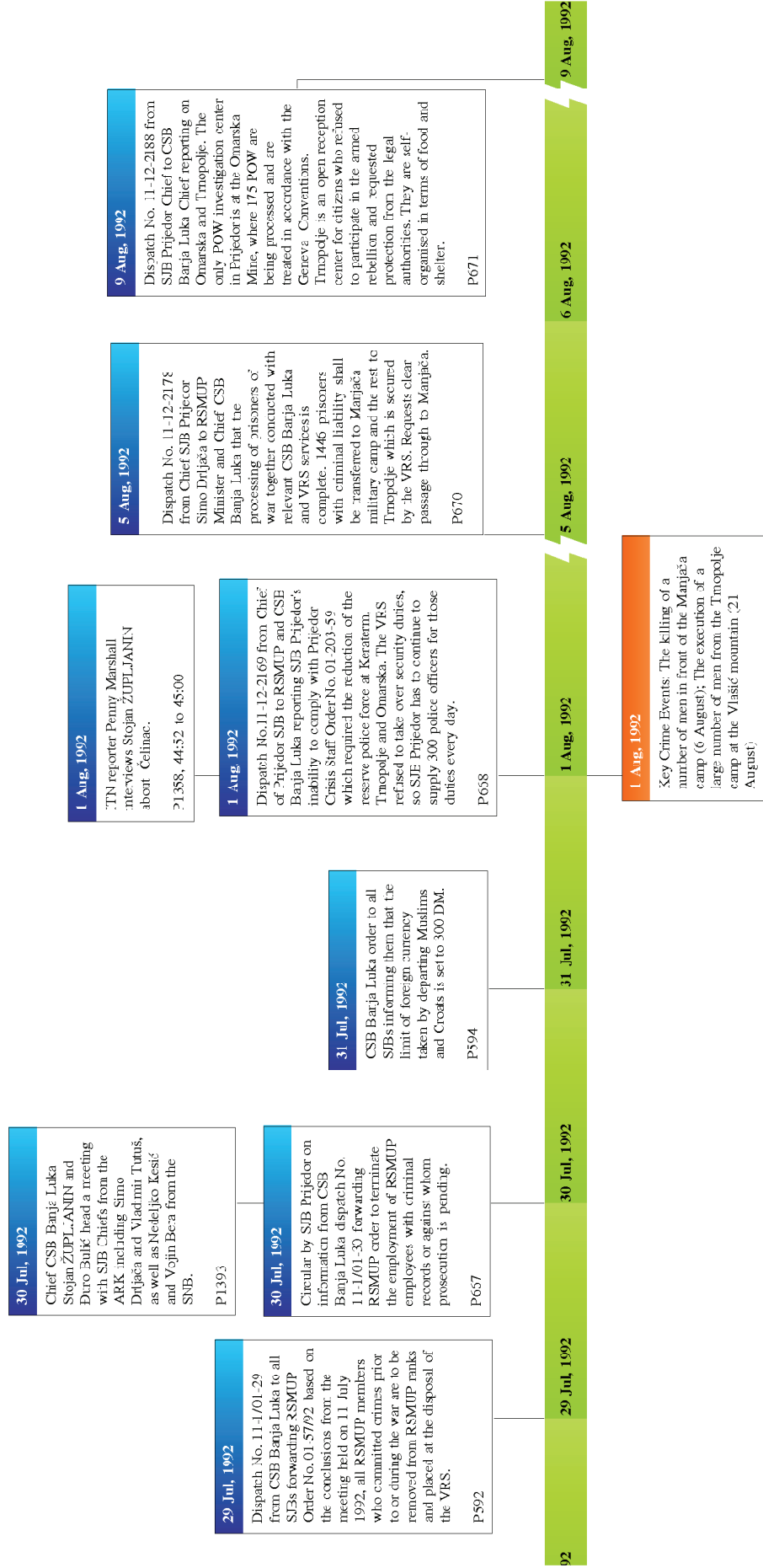

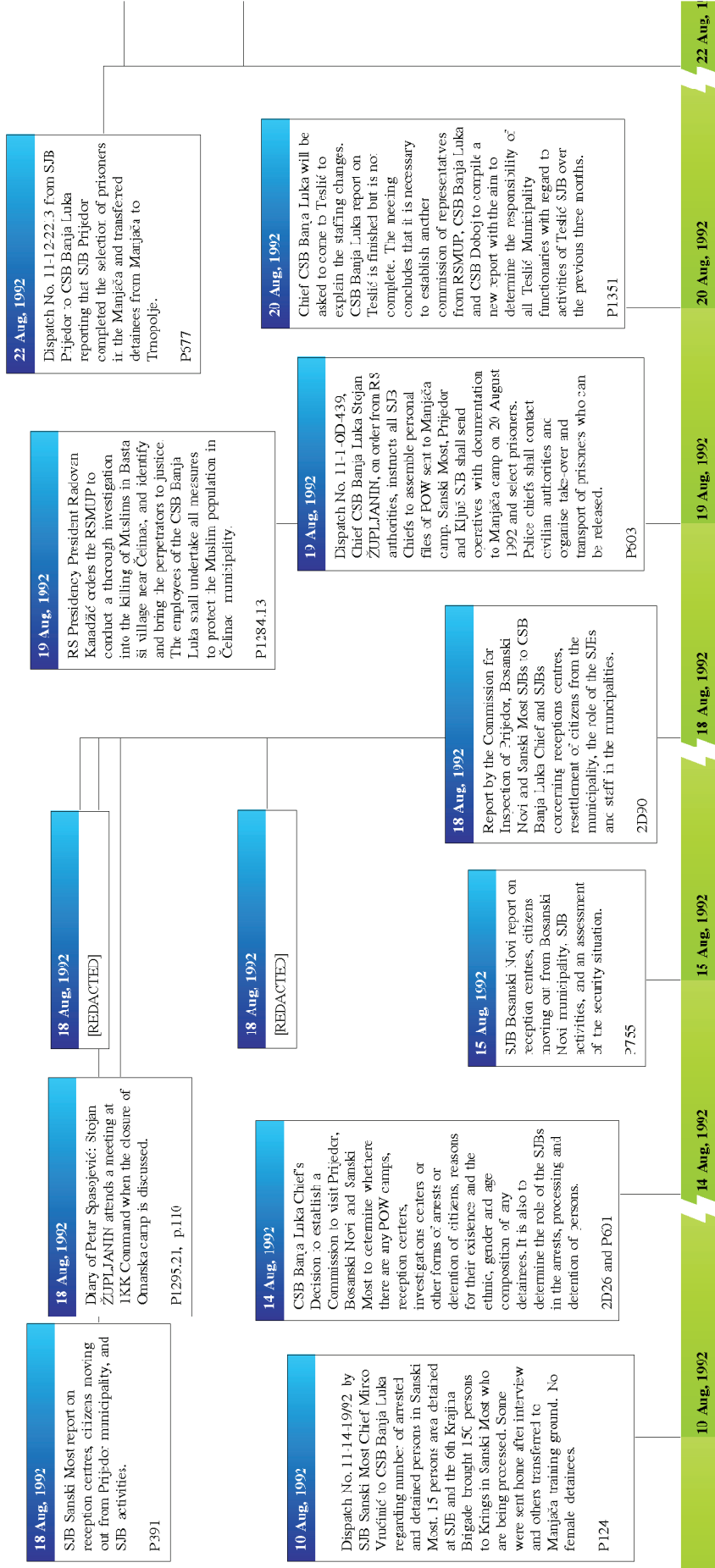

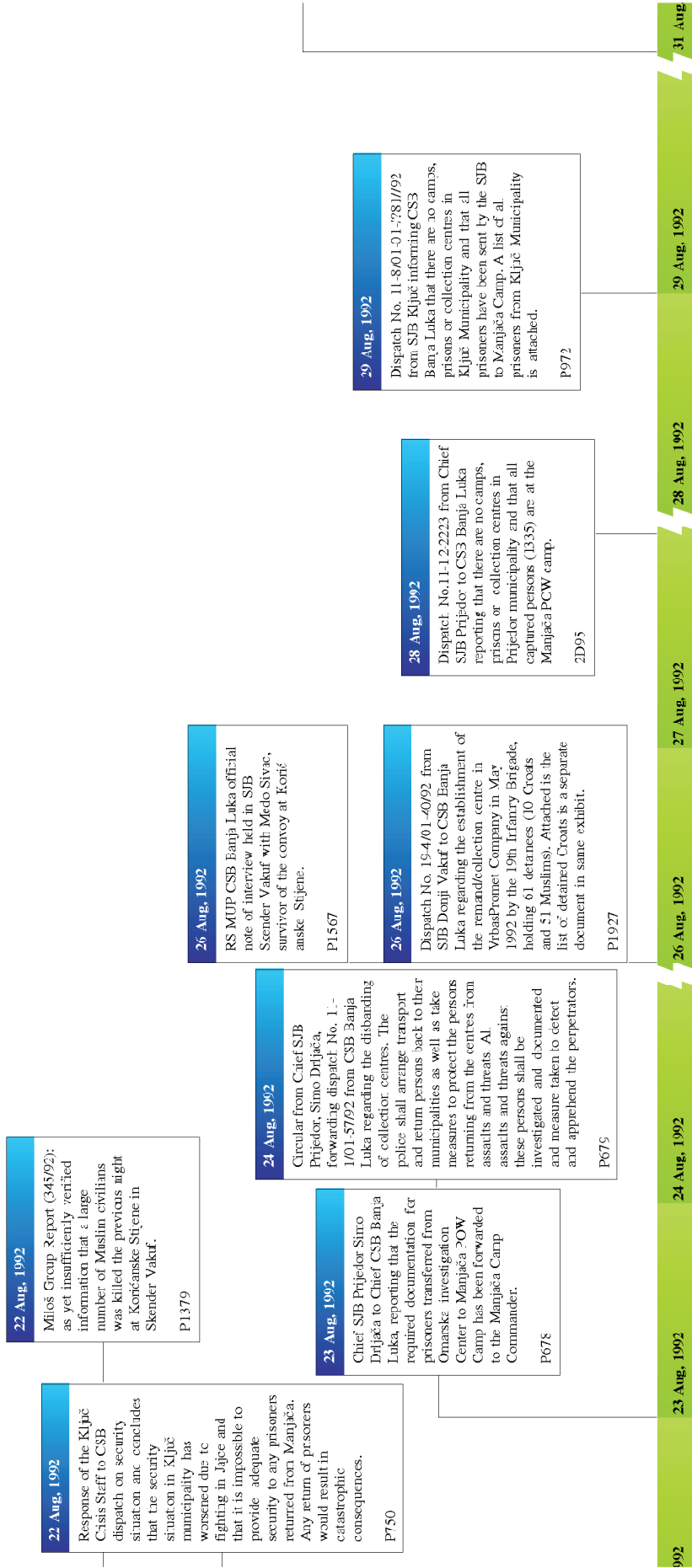
