KARADŽIĆ case

Completion of the trial

From 6 until 8 June 2011, Šešelj presented his case. He called five witnesses (*Witness DS-1, Zoran Dražilović, Nenad Jović, Zoran Rankić and Jovan Glamočanin*), after which the parties presented their closing arguments.

On 9 June 2011, the parties met before Judge Robinson for a Status Conference with all appellants present except Gvero.

Jelena RAŠIĆ case (“Contempt”)

Judge Morrison

On 9 June 2011, the parties met before Judge Morrison for a Status Conference in the absence of the accused.

HARADINAJ *et al.* case

Judge Moloto

On 9 June 2011, the parties met before Judge Agius for a Status Conference with the accused present.
