Trial Chamber I – Judges Orić (Presiding), Picard and Gwaunza

DECISION ON ANTE GOTOVINA’S APPLICATION FOR AN ORDER PURSUANT TO RULE 54BIS DIRECTING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS

On 19 July 2011, the Chamber dismissed Gotovina’s application requesting an order to Serbia to produce documents (in relation to, *inter alia*, to the departure of Serbian civilians from the “Krajina” region in August 1995).
