ORDER REPLACING JUDGES IN A CASE BEFORE THE APPEALS CHAMBER

On 22 April 2015, ICTY President Meron assigned Judges Flüggé, Pocar and Daqun to replace Judges Ramaroson, Khan and Tuzmukhamedov on the appeals bench in Stanišić&Župljanin case. The new Appeals Chamber in this case will therefore be composed of Judges Agius, Flüggé, Pocar, Daqun and Afande.

DEPUTY REGISTRAR'S SUBMISSION IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE DECISION ON REQUEST FOR RECLASSIFICATION OF EXPERT MEDICAL REPORTS

On 20 April 2015, following the Trial Chamber's previous instruction, the Deputy Registrar filed publicly the expert medical reports about the Hadžić's state of health. The reports were filed confidentially on 13 February 2015.

DECISION ON MOTION REFERRED TO THE PRESIDENT IN "DECISION ON 'MOTION TO INSTIGATE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST CARLA DEL PONTE'"

On 23 April 2015, ICTY President Meron dismissed Šešelj's motion to instigate (contempt) proceedings against Carla del Ponte, filed confidentially on 16 October 2013, due to lack of the ICTY competence on the matter. The Trial Chamber already found, on 16 June 2014, that the motion falls outside the ICTY competence because the MICT assumed the responsibility since 1 June 2013.
